

Leonard Suel Rites Are Set for Saturday

Democratic Leader and
Publisher Dies in
New Prague

Services for Leonard Suel, 37, of New Prague, Democratic nominee for state treasurer in the last election, will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at the St. Wenceslaus church in New Prague.

He died Wednesday in New Prague. Following an automobile accident in November, 1938, he was operated on for a head injury and never regained his health.

Suel was co-publisher of the New Prague Times, member of the Democratic state executive committee and

for three years Mr. Suel secretary to Congressman Elmer J. Ryan.

Born in Credit River, Minn., he attended schools there and at New Prague and St. Thomas college in St. Paul.

In 1936 he was president of the Congressional Secretaries club in Washington. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, Catholic Order of Foresters, New Prague Community club and New Prague Sportsman's club.

Surviving are his wife, four children, Jay Leonard, Rita, Corinne and Catherine of New Prague; his mother, Mrs. A. B. Suel of Prior Lake; three brothers, John L. of Robbinsdale, Arthur J. of New Prague and Frank L. of Credit River; and three sisters, Mrs. C. C. Weides and Mrs. L. J. Meskan of Minneapolis and Mrs. F. B. Kelly of Haddon Heights, N. J.
