

## FATHER CLEARY TO SAY SILVER JUBILEE MASS

Archbishop Murray, Other Church Officials Will Attend

Rev. John P. Cleary of St. Thomas parish will celebrate his silver jubilee as a priest with a solemn high mass June 7 at 10:30 a.m. in St. Thomas church, Forty-fourth street and Vincent avenue S.

A special celebration has been arranged for the day with Archbishop John Gregory Murray, St. Paul, and other high church officials in attendance.

### Dinner to Follow Mass

Monsignor Humphrey Moynihan will give the sermon. After the services, members of the parish will serve dinner in the church auditorium.

Dr. F. E. Harrington will be toastmaster at the dinner program honoring Father Cleary. Archbishop Murray and Joseph L. Murphy will speak.

Born in 1880 at Credit River, Minn., Father Cleary was graduated from St. Thomas college and ordained at St. Paul, June 9, 1911, by Archbishop Ireland. He said his first mass June 11, 1911, at Credit River.

### Pastor at St. Thomas in 1918

He became pastor of St. Thomas parish July 26, 1918, and directed the construction of a new church in 1925.
