

horses also creditable.—The Shakopee *Argus* says :—“The Hastings and Dakota railway company have finished the grading of the road between Credit river and Shakopee and are now engaged in laying the track down. On yesterday morning the track layers were within about two miles and a half of Shakopee. The workmen then run out of rails and are obliged to wait for about ten days before a further supply of iron will be on hand. When the iron arrives, about two days' work will bring the engine into the streets of this city.”—The October cattle fair at Shakopee was one of the largest ever held in Scott county.
