RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF WEIGHT LIMITS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS

WHEREAS, there are proposed improvements to County Roads 68 and 27 (roundabout construction) will result in an increase in truck traffic on town roads in the vicinity of the proposed improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, this anticipated increase in truck traffic will result in negative impacts to the pavement structure of these town roads as well as noise and dust impacts to neighboring properties, both residential and non-residential, along the roadways; and

WHEREAS, the town roads in the vicinity of the proposed improvements are Foxfield Drive, Oak Grove Avenue, Broadview Drive, 196th Street East, and Southfork Drive; and

WHEREAS, Credit River Township believes that roads identified above will be seriously damaged or destroyed unless the use of vehicles in excess of 5 tons are prohibited from traveling on said roads; and

WHEREAS, The Township is in the process of acquiring the necessary signs to post its roads at a weight limitation of 5 tons per axle.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Board of Credit River Township as follows:

- 1. The weight limit on Foxfield Drive, Oak Grove Avenue, Broadview Drive, 196th Street East, and Southfork Drive once posted pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 169.87 shall be limited to 5 tons per axle, except for those vehicles exempt by law.
- 2. Pursuant to Minnesota law, the weight restrictions shall be effective upon posting of the appropriate weight limitation signs.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to notify the County Sheriff of these weight limitations.
