**RESOLUTION ORDERING IMPROVEMENTS TO  
2022 OVERLAY PROJECT**


**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Credit River, Scott County, Minnesota has received a Feasibility Report for improvements to Bernard Avenue from Broadview Drive to the terminus, Broadview Drive from Broadview Avenue to County Road 27, Natchez Avenue from County Road 21 to 175<sup>th</sup> Street, 175<sup>th</sup> Street from Princeton Lane to Natchez Avenue, Princeton Lane from 175<sup>th</sup> Street to the terminus, Maureen Circle from Natchez Avenue to the terminus, and Jesse Lane from Natchez Avenue to terminus; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public improvement hearing held on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022 was properly mailed and published according to the requirements of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 429 at which all persons desiring to be heard were given an opportunity to be heard thereon.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CREDIT RIVER, SCOTT COUNTY, MINNESOTA:**
